Intermediate Certificate in Wines and Spirits

The Wine and Spirit Education Trust (WSET) Intermediate course leads towards the Intermediate Certificate in Wines and Spirits and is designed for people interested in developing and improving their knowledge of wines and spirits in a supportive environment.

The course is appropriate for people working with wine professionally in some capacity as well as those who enjoy wine and spirits, and wish to learn more about them. The sessions will include theory on wines and spirits followed by tutored tastings of a selection of wines and spirits, including fortified wines.

Subjects covered include

- Growing grapes and making wine
- Key grape varieties
- Sweet wines
- Sparkling wines
- Food and wine matching.

On successful completion of the Intermediate Certificate in Wines and Spirits candidates are eligible to study for the Advanced Certificate in Wines and Spirits.
